Treasurer's Report For the Year Ended 31 March 2024

The Balmain Athletics Club prepares its accounts on a cash basis and it ended its 52nd year in a strong financial position, with accumulated funds of \$179,398.49 comprising a NAB bank account and a Bendigo Bank account (trading as Balmain/Rozelle Community Bank). Equipment & uniforms have an estimated value of \$80,000 bringing net assets to \$259,398.49. The centre generated a deficit for the year of \$16,688.75 (2023 deficit: \$28,931.45).

From a revenue perspective I note the following:

- There was an increase in Registration fees in line with enrolment numbers trending back towards pre covid-19 levels. Registration fees include both junior and senior athletes and competition entry fees.
- Sponsorship fees remained in line with the prior year.
- Other income includes grant funding received in the year.
- Canteen income was largely in line with the prior year, reflecting a similar number of competition days and attendees.

From a cost perspective I note the following:

- Money continues to be spent on Uniforms and training apparel. There was no requirement to spend as much in the current year as in the prior year.
- Registration fees were paid to both Little Athletics NSW and ANSW in the year. Moving forward (and under the new partnership arrangement between both organisations, we will revert to paying only one registration fee).
- We pay our coaches to provide a high level of support to athletes. We increased the use of junior coaches in the year and this has driven the overall increase in this area. These payments are funded out of canteen and sponsorship income.
- Other significant costs include ground hire, equipment purchases, trophies and medals and charitable donations.

I would like to thank our Platinum sponsor Conti Strata, our Gold sponsor BAC Insurance Brokers and the Athlete's Foot Burwood for their continued support across the season.

I would also like to say a special thank you to our canteen & BBQ volunteers for their hard work and enthusiasm that contributed greatly to our result. I can confidently say that we can meet all of our financial obligations as and when they fall due.

Secretary's Report

(Club Review) We also held our first **Club Review** event on 11 May 2023 at Magpie Sports, Croydon Park from 6-8.30pm. 26 members attended including Age Managers, Coaches, Committee members, volunteers and parents - 13 female and 13 male. (ANSW and LANSW Offerings) The 2023/24 pre-season was dominated by a discussion and review of the Athletics NSW (**ANSW**) and Little Athletics NSW (**LANSW**) competition and membership offerings, following new offerings by ANSW presented in early June 2023. On Tuesday 27 June 2023, the Committee decided to register all members with both ANSW and LANSW for the 2023/24 Summer season.

Update: On 27 March 2024, ANSW and LANSW announced a partnership to provide a single athletics offering in NSW - [Our State, Our Sport, Our Pathway](#). This will provide Balmain athletes with one membership and a combined competition pathway. For the Club, there will be one affiliation cost and a combined online registration process. The Committee looks forward to ongoing collaboration with ANSW and LANSW towards achieving equitable outcomes for everyone involved in the sport of athletics in NSW.

¹ There were a range of suggestions made on how to achieve this and comments about how conflicting expectations/outcomes create tension around programming.

(Club Competition) At the Club level, the Saturday Summer competition and training season returned to King George Oval, Rozelle.

(Key considerations) Some key considerations for the Committee this season included:

- Improving the weekly Saturday competition program.
- Age Manager and Coach training.
- Adapting the weekly Club coaching offerings.
- Development of an equitable athletics program.
- Ongoing development of the senior athletics at the Club.

Registrar's Report

Overview: Registrations for the 2023/2024 season totalled 962. This was a slight increase from 2022/2023. The Tots program was very popular with a lot of interest over the season. The season began on Saturday 7th October and ended on Saturday 16th March 2024.

Registration process: The committee decided to delay the opening of online registrations to the public until Monday 7th August due to the previous technical issues with the Gameday platform. We sent details to 2022/23 members on Friday 4th August advising that they would have the weekend to register to allow them to have priority as returning members. There were issues with Gameday again, many of which were able to be rectified before opening registrations widely. The main problem this season was with the payment system, it appears Gameday had an internet browser preference.

The committee decided to accept both the ANSW and LANSW membership offerings this season and as a result, registration fees increased. There was no early bird offering, we opted for a priority registration period for returning members. Registration fees were \$160 for Tots and \$190 for U6-U17. The LANSW association fee component was \$60 per athlete for tots, \$80 per athlete for U6-U17. The ANSW association fee component was \$30 per athlete for Tots-U8 and \$40 per athlete for U9-U17. We also offered family discounts of 10% for 3, 15% for 4 and 20% for 5 siblings.

Numbers climbed at a slower pace than the 2022/23 season, likely due to the slight increase in fees and the reduction in the NSW Active Kids vouchers from \$100 to \$50.

The U7 boys age group closed on 25th September 2023 and Tots on 13th October 2023. We started waitlists for all these groups and reached our capacity on our waitlists as well.

Registration day: This season the Club held one registration day on Saturday 16th September 2023. At that time, 854 members had registered. Over 656 envelopes were collected which represents approximately 77% of the number of athletes.

We held a second registration pick up on the morning of our Intro day and from there packs were available for pick up from the Info tent before the competition started on Saturday mornings.

Midseason registration: LANSW didn't offer a reduction in their component of the registration fee for the latter part of the season (after Christmas/New Year break). We did offer those on the waitlist to join, as numbers had dropped off in the oversubscribed age groups. We had a few new registrations in the New Year but only a handful.

We also had a large number of trialists this season which was great to see. The majority of which turned into registrations, and those that trialed at the end of the season were keen to come back for our 24/25 season. Over the season we had 21 trialists attend one or more mornings at KGO.

GAMEDAY: Still had issues this season, however, compared to the previous 2 seasons these issues were minimal, and had to do with payments. These were rectified by the parent/guardian contacting LANSW and paying over the phone.

Other registration related comments:

- Two athletes transferred into the club in October and we had 3 transfers out of the Club to Inner West, 2 transferred to Tweed Head and 1 transferred to Newcastle.
- 16 registration numbers were lost or destroyed. The Club paid \$160 (16 x \$10) in lost registration number fees to LANSW.
- 1 registration number was transferred to Eastern Suburbs at regionals due to them not having any numbers left.

We note there will be a new registration system for the coming 2024/25 season with the partnership of ANSW & LANSW, all memberships will go through RevSport.

Coaching Report

Balmain Athletics Club takes pride in its Club Training, running on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the athletics season. Training is offered to athletes of all ages and abilities. The Club aims to provide a welcoming and nurturing environment with fun activities for young athletes to improve their skills and fitness, as well as specific skills-based coaching catering for more advanced competitors.

At the heart of Balmain Athletics Club's training program lies its commitment to inclusivity and diversity. Tuesday training sessions exemplify this ethos, with 'general club training' catering to athletes ranging from Under 6 to Under 17. This inclusive approach ensures that athletes of all ages have access to quality coaching and resources, encouraging enjoyment of physical exercise and fostering a sense of unity and friendship within the club.

A feature of Tuesday training is the incorporation of elements from the World Athletics Program for Under 6s and 7s, assisted by Athletics New South Wales (**ANSW**). This collaboration introduces young athletes to the fundamentals of athletics and lays the groundwork for continued development.

For older athletes, Tuesday training takes on a more specialised focus, with sessions dedicated to two events selected in accordance with the Saturday competition program. This targeted approach allows athletes to hone their skills and fine-tune their techniques under the guidance of coaches, maximising their performance on competition day.

Thursday training sessions are geared towards older athletes seeking more advanced, specific coaching for a single event per session. This tailored approach enables athletes to refine their techniques and address areas for improvement as they continue working towards new personal bests in a supportive environment.

Central to the success of Balmain Athletics Club is its exceptional coaching staff. Our coaches are not only knowledgeable and dedicated but also passionate about nurturing the next generation of athletes, providing individualised attention and guidance to help each individual reach their full potential.

During Saturday competitions, the commitment of our coaching staff extends beyond the training ground. In addition to coaching, the coaches also play many vital roles in hands-on setting up, packing up, officiating athlete events, providing support for athletes and parents. This hands-on involvement by our coaches is an important component of the smooth running of our busy Saturday mornings and is an integral part of our club community spirit.

Balmain Athletics Club offers a coaching program that is continually evolving in ways to nurture our athletes from beginners to elite levels.
